English Reading Test

	Marks available
Paper One: Short Text and questions (approx. 30 minutes)	20
Paper Two: Longer text with separate questions (approx. 30 minutes)	20
Total	40

There is a total of 40 marks available. The mark needed to achieve the expected standard varies from year to year, but if they get a total of **22** or more then they should be on track.

English Grammar, Punctuation and Spelling Test

	Marks available
Paper One: Spelling Test (approx. 15 minutes)	20
Paper Two: Questions (approx. 20 minutes)	20
Total	40

There is a total of 40 marks available. Again, the expected standard will vary each year, but if they get a total score of **25** or more, they should be on track.

Mathematics

	Marks available
Paper One: Arithmetic Test (approx. 20 minutes)	25
Paper Two: Reasoning Test (approx. 35 minutes)	35
Total	60

The mark needed to achieve the expected standard varies from year to year, but if they get a total of **37** or more out of 60 on these papers then they should be on track.
