## **NURSERY ADMISSIONS POLICY**

### **Admissions Criteria**

If nursery schools or classes receive more applications than there are places available, places will be offered using the criteria below and priority will be given to children who will be four at the time of admission. Priority will then be given using the criteria below to three year olds according to the term of their birthday.

1. Children with educational, medical or social needs (Applications on these grounds will have to be supported in writing by the relevant professional involved, such as a Social Worker or GP etc).
2. Children with a brother or sister at the same school when the child is due to be admitted.
3. Children whose parents choose the school on denominational grounds. Applicants are required to provide a supporting letter from their vicar with the application. (Voluntary Controlled Schools only).
4. Children whose parents are teachers at the school.
5. Children who live closest to the school (A straight line on a map from the parental home to the school is used to calculate the distance).

(If places cannot be offered to all the applicants in one of the categories above then places will be offered to the applicants in that category who are closest to the school).

### **Explanatory Notes**

Places are only offered to children resident in other LEAs once children resident in Slough have been offered a place. Applications should be referred to the LEA (Customer Services Section) for approval.

Full-time places are only available at some nursery schools, and only if a relevant professional such as a GP or Social Worker states in writing why a full-time place is necessary. There are a limited number of full-time places that can be offered and each case will be considered on its merits by the school.

Applications can be made after the child's second birthday for possible admission the term following the child's third birthday.

There are Borough wide closing dates for applications and all applications received by the dates will be considered. No reference will be made as to when a parent expressed an interest in a place, applied for a place or registered a child's name. (this is in line with the latest DfEE guidance on admissions).

Most nursery schools and classes admit children each term. The closing dates for applications will be the same as for statutory age children and published in the admissions booklet.

Parents may be asked for proof of address.

Unsuccessful applicant will be considered with the next batch of applications.
